HORSE USAGE:	Horse usage will be as per Chapter 3 point 708. from VASA Rules 12th Edition August 2020. In 1 competition date, a single horse shall be used NO MORE THAN 12 CANTER ROUNDS of 1 minute each or the equivalent (For example 6 canter rounds of 2 minutes each) and NO MORE THAN 24 WALK ROUNDS OF 2 MINUTES EACH or the equivalent (for example 48 walk rounds of 1 minute each). The O.C reserves the right to change the rounds according to times and horse usage.
MEDIC:	Will be stationed on the property at the indoor arena.

PROGRAM TIMES:	Times will be determined by the number of entries. Times on the programme are provisional & only a guideline. If classes are running early, they will follow on.
MUSIC:	Please email music to Nicole Allen nixterriallen@gmail.com before Sunday 11 April 2021. Music will be accepted in Mp3 format. Please label music: First name last name - Grade / class - Run in/ Compulsory/ Freestyle- song name. No music will be accepted on the day of the show.
HORSE VACCINATIONS AND PASSPORTS:	Equine Flu vacs must be administered within 6 months + 21 days of the day of the show. No horse may compete in the 7 days after the vaccinations. AHS vaccinations must be in order. PLEASE BRING HORSE PASSPORTS WITH YOU TO THE SHOW. A fine and yellow card will be issued to the owner of any horse contravening these rules.
GENERAL:	Catering will be available. PLEASE SUPPORT KZN VAULTING No dogs will be allowed. Horse owners/vaulters/grooms/coaches are responsible for picking up horse droppings and personal litter in yard, practice and competition arenas.

PRIZE GIVING:	KZN vaulting reserves the right to combine male and female or age categories should there be insufficient entries per category. Results will be published on the KZN Community what's app group and ultimately onto the VASA website.
RULES:	NEW 2020 VASA RULES 12th edition WILL APPLY. The organisers reserve the right to consolidate the duration of the show into one day as well as amend the number of rounds, depending on the number of entries, cancel, combine and restrict classes and or age and gender groups. No parent, coach or vaulter or any other person may approach the judges directly during the show for any reason whatsoever, all queries, complaints etc. Must be presented to and discussed with the Show Director only. Any complaints of any nature must follow the SAEF general regulations. A form must be obtained from the show director, filled in and R 1000 money deposited up to 30 minutes after the last class. The show organisers will not entertain any complaints unless this procedure has been followed. The show organisers or their representatives, venue owners and officials will not be held responsible for any loss, damage, theft or injury sustained by horses, vaulters, appointed officials, the public or their property whatsoever.

On arrival the COVID 19 officer Mrs Taryn Curtis will take your temperature and you will need to fill out the COVID 19 register. 3. Please always maintain social distancing of 1.5 meters. 4. Horse boxes to be parked at least 5 m apart. 5. Please sanitise your hands-on arrival and at the hand sanitising areas throughout the show. 6. IF YOU ARE FEELING SICK PLEASE DO NOT COME TO THE SHOW. 7. MASKS ARE COMPULSORY AT ALL TIMES EXCEPT WHEN VAULTING.
