HORSE USAGE	VASA APPENDICES (3 Dec 2018) - Horse usage as per APPENDIX I In 1 competition day, a single horse shall be used NO MORE THAN 12 CANTER ROUNDS of 1 minute each or the equivalent (for example 6 canter rounds of 2 minutes each) and NO MORE THAN 24 WALK ROUNDS of 2 minutes each or the equivalent (for example, 48 walk rounds of 1 minute each). The OC reserves the right to change the rounds according to times and horse usage i.e. one & one and half to two rounds per class and rule 71.12.3 applies.		

MEDICS	Will be stationed on the property in close proximity to the arena.

KOLES	The OC reserves the right to consolidate the duration of the show into one day as well as amend the	
	number of Rounds depending on the number of entries, cancel, combine and restrict classes and/or	
	age and gender groups.	
	No parent, coach or vaulter or any other persons may approach the judges directly during the show	
	for any reason whatsoever. All queries, complaints etc must be presented to and discussed with	
	THE SHOW DIRECTOR ONLY.	
	Any complaints of any nature must follow the SAEF General Regulations.	
	A form must be obtained from the Show Director, filled in and R1000 money deposited up to 30	
	minutes after the last class. The OC and/or the Show Holding Body will not entertain any complaints	
	unless this procedure has been followed. The OC or their representatives and officials will not be held	
	responsible for any loss, damage, theft or injury sustained by horses, vaulters, appointed officials, the	
	public or their property whatsoever.	
	See Rule 704 regarding substitutions. The horse may be changed up to 30 MINUTES before the start	
	of the 1st test of the competition of that particular horse. Any substitutions must be presented on	
	the official substitution form to the Show director ONLY and confirmed within the time period	
	stipulated above. All substituted horses MUST be entered in the event and registered with VASA and	
	failure to adhere to this requirement will entail disqualification.	
	Substitution in relation to a Squad competition, a vaulter may be substituted with the reserve vaulter	
	within 30 minutes before the start of the 1st test of the competition for squads. This substitution	
	must be presented on the official form to the show director ONLY and confirmed within the time	
	period stipulated above. All substituted vaulters MUST be entered in the event and registered with	
	a Club, VASA and SAEF and failure to adhere to this requirement will entail disqualification. There	
	may only be 1 substitution per event.	
	If a member of the squad is injured or ill (Doctors Note required), during a test they may be	
	substituted with the reserve for the next test/tests with the accompanied substitution form as listed	
	above.	
	See Vaulting Rules, Rule 711.3 regarding the Prize Giving Ceremony - In order to participate at awards	
	presentations, vaulters must be dressed in Club tracksuits/attire or unitards. Lungers must be neat	
	and smartly dressed. Suitable closed toe shoes are obligatory.

THE SHOW WILL BE RUN UNDER STRICT COVID REGULATIONS AS APPROVED BY THE MINISTER OF SPORT FOR THE RESUMPTION OF EQUESTRIAN SPORT

- 1. All vaulters, officials, staff, support staff and medics agree and confirm to comply with the SA Government and SAEF Covid-19 guidelines and protocols as set out on the SAEF website www.saef.org.za when entering a show/event.
- 2. A vaulter may only be accompanied by the driver trucking the horse, a lunger and a groom. In the case of underage riders, they may be accompanied by one parent or guardian. No spectators are allowed.
- 3. All attendees will be obliged to report to the COVID 19 Officer/employee, upon entry of the premises to sign the register, sanitise their hands, and have their temperature taken and recorded. The name of the Compliance Officer will be indicated on the schedule. Showholding bodies to get clearance and permission from the Compliance Officer to add their contact number to the schedule as well.
- 4. It is compulsory for all attendees to wear masks on the property at all times and adhere to social distancing protocols.
- 5. Vaulters may warm-up and compete without a mask. Vaulters must return to his/her parking spot upon completion of his/her round to untack. A cool down period of 15 minutes is allowed, and the vaulter should then leave the premises as soon as possible afterwards.
- 6. There will be no prize giving ceremony. Results will be published via social media groups and posted online on the VASA website.
- 7. Although the Showholding Body has taken all necessary precautions to ensure compliance to Covid-19 protocols and guidelines as stipulated by the Department of Health, it is important to note that neither The Hout Bay Riding Centre, VASA nor SAEF can be held responsible for any person contracting COVID19 at the said venue. All attendees are entering the venue at their own risk.
- 8. Should any attendee at the show contravene any of the Covid-19 regulations, then he/she will be asked by the Covid-19 Compliance Officer to leave the venue immediately. There will be no refunds for show entries.
